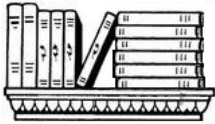

Planning Meeting Monday, January 4, 2016

Participants in the Morning Book Discussion Program will meet on Monday, January 4, 2016 at 10 a.m., at the library to put together the list of books for 2016. The list will be drawn from the titles that have been collected during the 2015 meetings. Suggestions include fiction, non-fiction, biography/autobiography, classics, and something with a local flavor.

The group usually meets the first Monday of each month at the library. The library arranges for multiple copies of the titles through inter-library loan for participants to borrow. Participants take turns providing a light refreshment. The program, suitable for adults, is open to all Mont Vernon library patrons - get your card for free! For bookkeeping purposes, non-residents who would like to borrow a book will be asked to join the library for the annual fee of \$15. The list of titles will be posted on the library's website, published in the next newsletter, and posted in the library. The first discussion will be held on Monday, February 1, at 10 a.m.

Trustees' Report – Jane King

The town meeting regarding use of town buildings (include the Daland Library building) was held. It was decided that a warrant article should be put to town vote in order to secure funds for a professional assessment on town building use, capacity and repairs. There will be another (repeat) meeting in January on use of town buildings for all the folks who missed the first one. The warrant article will likely be out in March. It was remarked that of the three buildings studied, the Daland Library is in the best condition.

New Business

Membership Drive & Incentives: Jessica and Mary Katharine are exploring ideas for different incentives for the 4 levels of FOTL membership (\$15, \$25, \$50 and \$250/Lifetime). Some ideas for the drive include a booth at the town dump and at all town celebrations (Spring Gala, Lamson Farm Day, etc.), encouraging parents to buy teachers at MVS a FOTL Membership as a teacher appreciation gift.
